What's the difference between being trustworthy and being incorruptible?

What does the condition of your relationships say about your integrity? What would your spouse or best friend say?

Read Hebrews 4:12 We should treasure God's Word above all worldly counsel. Share a time when God's Word pierced your heart and caused a change in your life.
